- student town hall: event held on Tuesday, November 24 with Seneca Student Federation President Krisha Amin
- Seneca Au Large
 - Equity, Diversity and Inclusion Committee has been struck and will be holding its inaugural meeting shortly
 - o Working Remotely Committee members will be announced soon
 - o Employee stipend announced recently \$350 will be provided to all active full-time employees and \$175 to all active part-time employees
 - Extended the holiday break by two days Seneca will close on Wednesday,
 December 23 and reopen on Tuesday, January 5
 - Pulse Survey issued yesterday, Wednesday, November 25, to all employees to receive feedback on working remotely during the pandemic and how they see themselves working post-pandemic
 - o Sustainability: Seneca-wide sustainability plan being created
