Workplace Safety and Insurance Board or Private Insurance Coverage

Students on Unpaid Work Placements

Student coverage while on placement

The government of Ontario, through the Ministry of Advanced Education and Skills Development (MAESD), reimburses WSIB for the cost of benefits it pays to Student Trainees enrolled in an approved program at Seneca College. Ontario students are eligible for Workplace Safety Insurance Board (WSIB) coverage while on unpaid work placements as required by their program of study. MAESD also provides private insurance to students should their unpaid placement required by their program of study take place with an employer who is not covered under the *Workplace Safety and Insurance Act*.

Furthermore, there is private insurance coverage for students at Seneca College whose unpaid work placements are arranged by their postsecondary institution to take place outside of Ontario.

I have read and understand that WSIB or private insurance coverage will be provided through the Ministry of Advanced Education and Skills Development while I am on unpaid work placements as arranged by Seneca College as a requirement of my program of study.
