Seneca is committed to receiving and responding to feedback from all persons with disabilities regarding how Seneca provides accessible services to them. If a person with a disability has concerns or feedback regarding the services provided by Seneca, they can provide this feedback in any of the following methods.

Students

- 1. By providing input/feedback to Seneca office/personnel
- 2. By contacting Accessible Learning Services

Employees

- 1. By providing feedback to Manager or Supervisor
- Feedback may also be submitted in person, by telephone, in writing, or via email:
 - a. By visiting the <u>Accessibility at Seneca space</u> and completing the <u>AODA</u> Feedback Form
 - b. By emailing <u>barrieridentification@senecacollege.ca</u>
 - c. By completing the Community Barrier Identification Form

All efforts will be made to provide any follow-up documentation in a format that takes into account the person's disability.
