The Program has been designed to prepare students for careers as Estheticians, able to provide the entire range of professional services offered in modern esthetics salons and spas. Students will also be trained in the psychology of selling and the practicalities of business within the salon and spa environment.

The Program integrates theory and practical work, with at least 50% of the curriculum devoted to practical application of classroom theory and techniques.

### ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Program Eligibility:

Ontario Secondary School Diploma with a majority of senior credits at the College Preparation (C), University (U) or University/College Preparation (M) level or Mature Student Status (19 years or older)

Grade 12 English: ENG4 (C) or ENG4 (U)

#### Before classes commence students must have:

Completed medical form

A valid Standard First Aid Certificate with Adult CPR (minimum 16 hours)

Applicant Selection:

Previous academic achievement (i.e. grades in pre-requisite subjects or their equivalents), will provide the basis upon which selection of applicants is determined. Students accepted into the program will write a placement test for English (skills test). In the event of over subscription, pre-admission testing, a college questionnaire, and/or attendance at an orientation may be required.
