

OBTAINING PERSISTENT LINKS TO FULL TEXT ARTICLES

OPEN ACCESS JOURNALS WITH DOIs (Digital Object Identifiers)

1. Find the article that you are interested in.

2. Copy and paste the DOI into a text editor (the DOI is a unique and persistent identifier for each article).
3. Convert the DOI into a URL by adding this prefix "**http://dx.doi.org/**"
4. The example: **http://dx.doi.org/10.2174/1874123100802010001** is a persistent link to the article above.
5. Test links prior to posting via email, course web pages etc.
