

Reading your Timetable

First, you see the course code, which is the three letters followed by three numbers (ECE 157 CC).

The last one-to-three letters you see (A, BB, TLC) indicate which section you are in. Programs are often split into more than one section, to make sure class sizes are not too big. Below the course code is the location of where your room is, which may appear differently depending on what campus you are attending.

You will see a letter followed by a four digit number. In this example we see the letter E. This indicates that your classroom is located in the E building of the college. Following the letter is a number. The first of these numbers indicates which level your room is located on. The last three numbers are the room number of your class
